



## Getting married at St. Nicholas' Church - Fees and Costs 2012

---

**The initial cost of a wedding at St. Nicholas Church, without music, is £534**

Most couples will need to add the charges for an organist to this, and you may also request the choir and the bellringers, with the resulting charges set out further below.

The usual initial cost is made up from the following:

The national fees set annually for a Church of England wedding:

<b>Clergy Fee (sent to the Diocese)</b>	<b>£141</b>
<b>PCC fee for Wedding Service and Banns</b>	<b>£143</b>

We ask for additional payments to support the local church:

<b>Building support costs</b>	<b>£115</b>
<b>Verger and administration</b>	<b>£95</b>

*These payments are voluntary, but the church relies upon them for the maintenance of its ministry.*

The cost of attending a Relate preparation course:

<b>Relate Marriage Preparation course</b>	<b>£40</b>

*We assume you wish to take part, unless you inform us otherwise.*

The following charges depend on your choice about organist, choir, bells & video recording:

<b>Organist fee</b>	<b>£71</b>
<b>(Organist fee if the service is video recorded)</b>	<b>£95</b>
<b>Choir fee</b>	<b>£68</b>
<b>Bellringers and bell maintenance fee</b>	<b>£125</b>

When you have decided on your wedding choices, we will be able to tell you the total cost of your church wedding.

### **Total cost of your church wedding:**

We ask for a deposit of £50 against these fees at the time you arrange your wedding.

Fees can be paid by cheque made out to 'Codsall PCC' up to a month before the wedding. Please pay the balance of your fees at the Wedding Preparation morning, normally held in March, or by coming to the Enquiry Evening.
